



THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VICTORIA BEACH

BY-LAW NO. 1626

A By-law of the Rural Municipality of Victoria Beach to establish a Police Board.

WHEREAS Subsection 26 (1) of The Police Services Act provides, as follows:

26(1) Every municipality that operates a police service must establish and maintain a police board in accordance with this Division;

AND WHEREAS Subsection 30(1) of The Police Services Act provides, in part, as follows:

30(1) The Council of a municipality must establish the size of its police board by by-law. The police board must

(a) consist of at least three members, in the case of a municipality with a population of 5,000 or less;

AND WHEREAS Subsection 30(2) of The Police Services Act provides, in part, as follows:

30(2) One member of a police board is to be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, and the other members are to be appointed by the council;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Victoria Beach, in Council assembled, enacts as follows:

1. A Police Board for the Rural Municipality of Victoria Beach is hereby established;
2. The Police Board shall consist of five (5) members;
3. The members shall be appointed as follows:
 - (a) Four (4) members shall be appointed by council;
 - (b) The four council appointed members shall consist of one member of council and three other members;
 - (c) Appointments shall be established by resolution of council;
4. Council shall appoint the Chair and Vice-Chair of the Police Board by resolution of council;
5. Remuneration of members of the Police Board who are not members of council or employees of the municipality shall be set by resolution of council;
6. By-law No. 1546 is hereby repealed.
