Approval of Minutes of October 12 2021 Meeting

Report from the Board

1) Council has passed a By-Law increasing the size of the Board from 3 members to 5 members. In accordance with that By-Law, Council has appointed Mr. Smith to the Board. The Department of Justice has yet to appoint the provincial representative to the Board.

2) Chief Constable Birkett commenced his tenure on November 1, 2021, bringing with him a wealth of policing experience.

3) Chief Constable MacPherson finished his interim position on December 31, 2021.

4) Patrol Sergeant Andy Boehm has been hired as a second full time police officer commencing January 4, 2022.

5) The Board met with Mr. Bartmanovich, as Councillor, and Mayor McMorris in early December to receive an update with respect to the RM's plan to establish a Community Safety Officer program.

Report from Chief Constable Birkett

Chief Constable Birkett reported as follows:

1) There has not been much activity or service call of note to report.

2) Patrol Sergeant Boehm is familiarizing himself with his role as a full time officer in the community.

3) Chief Birkett is searching for a third full time officer or two part time officers for the summer months.
