



THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VICTORIA BEACH
BY-LAW 1546

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Victoria Beach for the purposes of establishing a Police Board

WHEREAS Section 26(1) of The Police Services Act, C.C.S.M., Cap. P94.5, provides as follows:

26(1) "Every municipality that operates a police service must establish and maintain a police board in accordance with this Division"

AND WHEREAS Section 30(1) of The Police Services Act provides in part as follows:

30(1) The Council of a municipality must establish the size of its police board by by-law. The police board must
(a) consist of at least three members, in the case of a municipality with a population of 5,000 or less;


NOW THEREFORE THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VICTORIA BEACH, in Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. A Police Board for the Rural Municipality of Victoria Beach is hereby established.
2. The Police Board shall consist of three (3) members.
3. The members shall be appointed as follows
 - a. Two (2) members of the board shall be appointed by council.
 - b. The two appointed members shall consist of one member of council and one other member.
 - c. Appointments shall be established by resolution of council.
4. Council shall appoint the chair and vice-chair of the police board by resolution of council.
5. Remuneration to members of the police board who are not members of council or employees of the municipality shall be set by resolution of council.
