And Whereas the Independent Investigation is now complete and Councillor Axworthy was found to be in breach of several sections of the Manitoba Councils Code of Conduct legislation, RMVB Council Code of Conduct By-Law #1611, and the RMVB Respectful Workplace Policy.

Be it Resolved that Councillor Axworthy will:

1. Undertake mandatory formal governance and Council conduct training within 60 days of this Resolution;
2. Provide a formal written letter of apology to the complainant within 30 days of this Resolution, facilitated by the CAO based on the findings of the Investigator, acknowledging that his behaviour during and following the October 7 and October 21, 2026 Council Meetings was inappropriate and inconsistent with the RM's Code of Conduct expectations;
3. Be suspended for 30 days from all Council Committees or bodies on which the member serves: a) Doctors Committee, b) Fire Committee, c) Trails Committee, d) Communications Committee

Further Be it Resolved that the RMVB Council will agree to:

Undertake a comprehensive governance update and participate in preventative Council Conduct initiatives aimed at strengthening Council processes, meeting management, conflict resolution mechanisms, and Code of Conduct awareness moving forward.
